Theme: School of the Future



Categories: Primary years R-6, Middle years 7-9, Senior years 10-12

Timeline: films to be submitted end of Term 2 2009.

Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third places in each category.

Length of film: 3- 5 minutes.

Format: DVD or Photostory (PC)/iMovie (MAC) – using people, photos, drawings or puppets/clay figures.

Assessment criteria: The film must contain a spoken as well as visual element. It will be assessed according to:

- Language pronunciation & grammatical accuracy
- Range of language used (according to level of schooling)
- Technical competence
- Creativity demonstrated
